Available Position: Assistant/Associate Professor – Medical Director of ACOM Clinic

Location: Alabama College of Osteopathic Medicine, Dothan, AL

The Medical Director of the ACOM Clinic is primarily responsible for the oversight of clinic patient osteopathic health care by staff and clinicians as well as providing a clinical venue for the integration of ACOM curriculum as experiential training for ACOM students. The Medical Director is also a full-time clinical faculty member. This position is a mix of academic precepting, patient care, and administrative responsibilities.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Lead development of vision and annual goals for clinic care practices and effectively communicate/engage practice staff;
- Participate in the mentoring, advising, and/or supervising of medical, graduate, fellows, or other health professional students;
- Implement clinical experiences for students at the clinic and oversee clinic student assessment processes;
- Evaluate student progress in developing and applying clinical knowledge and skills appropriate to the clinical setting;
- Provide oversight of clinic staff in the performance of their clinic duties;
- Contribute to the development and implementation of standards of practice, including physician compensation and support staff
- Work to address the challenges facing primary care with a positive attitude, encouraging same from other primary care physicians;
- Organize practice management team to ensure effective and efficient management;
- Coordinate faculty clinic scheduling with Associate Dean of Clinical Sciences;
- Implement and oversee faculty precepting of ACOM student clerkshipwork in the clinic;
- Participate in patient care delivery at the clinic
- Develop team-based clinic care through interprofessional training, guidance, role definition, and ongoing assessment of all staff, faculty, student, and fellow activities as team members;
- Create and conduct quality improvement initiatives as appropriate using patient satisfaction, staff, faculty, and student satisfaction of team-based care and performance of ACOM curriculum to promote same;
- Monitor and contribute to oversight of clinical financial performance with clinic office manager and Dean and Associate Dean of Clinical Sciences;
- Conduct faculty physician clinic performance assessment and review;
- Conduct clinic staff assessment in conjunction with clinic office manager;
- Participate in professional and scientific meetings to further individual knowledge and to contribute to the development of other professionals;

- Other duties as assigned by the Dean or his/her designee.

Required Qualifications:

- MD or DO
- Eligibility for licensure in Alabama
- Board certification
- Demonstrated experience in teaching or postdoctoral training
- Excellent interpersonal, verbal, and communication skills
- Demonstrated ability to complete multiple tasks/assignments and meet deadlines
- Demonstrated ability to exercise good judgment and leadership skills
- Excellent organizational skills and detail oriented

Preferred Qualifications:

- Demonstrated experience in effective teaching from an accredited College of Osteopathic Medicine; or
- Demonstrated experience working with an integrated curriculum and experience in graduate program administration or as medical director in an academic clinical setting
