POSITION DETAILS

The Director of Research and Grant Development provides support to our faculty and students who are involved in research and related scholarly activities. This position coordinates and provides support to the growth of research across the ACOM campus. It oversees research strategy development and actively works to identify research-funding opportunities. This position manages research and development efforts among ACOM divisions and the office of the Vice President for Institutional Effectiveness. The Director works with ACOM divisions to identify grant and research opportunities. Additionally, the director will assist affiliated medical education programs with research and scholarly activities.

- ▶ Master's in Science, Technology, Engineering, Mathematics, Business, Public Administration, or a related field and five years of work-related experience in overseeing grants and conducting research projects required. A Ph.D. is preferred.

Established in 2013, the college is the academic division of Southeast Health, a not-for-profit community health system that also includes a regional medical center, an extensive network of clinics and specialty services, and a philanthropic foundation; all serving a tri-state area including southeast Alabama, southwest Georgia, and northwest Florida.
