Summer Boot Camp

Dear Incoming Students,

Congratulations on your acceptance to the Alabama College of Osteopathic Medicine (ACOM)! As you prepare to begin your medical education, we are pleased to offer an opportunity to strengthen your foundational knowledge before the academic year starts. Our Summer Boot Camp is an **optional, four-week intensive program** designed for incoming first-year students who wish to gain early exposure to Medical Gross Anatomy, Neuroanatomy, and Histology. This immersive course runs Monday through Friday, from 8:30 AM to 4:00 PM, on the ACOM campus.

The program is structured to provide hands-on, interactive learning in a supportive, low-pressure environment. While quizzes and assessments will be graded and returned to help you monitor your progress, they will **not be recorded** in your academic record. The focus is on enhancing your understanding and building confidence in core subjects that will be integral to your success in medical school.

Program Overview

- Anatomy Sessions: Each morning begins with a faculty-led overview of a specific anatomical region, followed by small-group breakout sessions and hands-on experience in the anatomy laboratory working with donor specimens. The session concludes with a mock practical exam, designed to mirror the rigor of medical school assessments.
- **Histology Sessions:** Integrated with anatomy instruction, these sessions focus on the identification of tissues, with guidance from faculty and experienced students.
- **Neuroanatomy Sessions:** This component of the program covers sectional anatomy of the central nervous system, including indepth study of the brain and spinal cord.

Key Benefits

- Gain a Competitive Advantage: Strengthen your understanding of foundational medical sciences before the semester begins.
- Develop Effective Study Strategies: Engage in active learning and collaborative study sessions with peers.
- Foster Early Connections: Build relationships with faculty and fellow students, establishing a strong support network.
- Adapt to the Medical School Environment: Become familiar with the pace and expectations of your coursework in a low-pressure setting.

- Tuition & Deposit:
 - Total Tuition: \$700
 - **Deposit:** A \$50 deposit is required at the time of registration. This deposit will be applied toward tuition, reducing the final cost to \$650.
 - Limited Seats: Registration is on a first-come, first-served basis. Early registration is encouraged to secure your spot.
- Schedule:
 - Orientation: Friday, June 20th
 - Classes Begin: Monday, June 23rd
 - Final Day: Friday, July 18th
 - **Time Commitment:** While structured learning **ends at 4:00 PM**, students are encouraged to dedicate additional time in the evenings and weekends for review and group study.
